Carcase Judging - Thursday 7th October 2021. Please read NFYFC Rules for full procedure, marks and details. *Note that a practice night for all Clubs will be held on the Thursday 3rd October BKP TG Sargeants, Bramshall (subject to invitation).*

Full Team of 9 – (Junior) 3 members 16 or under on 1.9.21
 (Inter) 3 members 21 or under on 1.9.21
 (Senior) 3 members 28 or under on 1.9.21

Clubs may enter any members who wish to do the competition just for practice providing they notify the Steward when booking in. There will be no live judging; otherwise competition is as per NFYFC rules. One member from each age group to judge one class of carcasses each and give reasons. Two teams of two members (1 senior / 1 intermediate) may be entered into the NFYFC Beef and Sheep Live and Carcase Judging at the English Winter Fair. A composite team will go forward to the YFC Stock and Carcase Judging Classes at English Winter Fair in November.
