NFYFC Cookery Competition – Thursday 10th March 2022. Please read NFYFC Rules for full procedure, marks and details. Teams to consist of 3 members, 1 must be 28 or under, 1 21 or under and 1 16 or under on 1.09.21. Each team will be required to prepare and display four courses for a Gala Dinner celebrating HRH Queen Elizabeth II's Platinum Jubilee, courses should include local produce where possible. All teams to supply their own gas stoves which will be subject to safety checks. The winning team will go forward to represent the County at the NFYFC Finals held at The Malvern Autumn Show, Saturday 24th September 2022.

Note no cooking will be done using electricity.

Tablecloths to cover the tables will be supplied. All teams to bring along trivets/wooden blocks to place their pans and gas stoves on that will provide suitable protection to the tables.

Gas Stoves – please let us know if you wish to loan one.

All food items and equipment used by the teams must be taken away by the competitors, after the judging and results have been finished. There will be washing up facilities available to use.

IMPORTANT - PLEASE NOTE:

- Members must be joined (form into the office) no later than Monday 7th March 2022
- Any club who withdraws within 7 days of the competition will receive a £10 fine and -6 points
- Any members aged 17 years and under must complete a parental permission slip via JotForm no later than 12noon on Wednesday 9th March 2022 <https://form.jotform.com/220474851511350> or scan the QR code
- All members taking part must bring a current membership card (2021-22) containing their photo
