
ENTRY FEE:

£20 PER RAFT TO BE PAID CASH ON THE DAY – NOTE <u>THIS WILL NOT BE INVOICED</u> TO YOUR CLUB SO PLEASE ENSURE IT IS PAID ON THE DAY. RECEIPTS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR ANY CLUB RECORDS ON THE DAY IF NEEDED.

TIMING:

All stewards as named above to meet at the site at 4.30pm for a full safety briefing. All rafts and competitors to arrive for safety checks and full safety briefing no later than 5pm.

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ELIGIBILITY: Teams on each raft of four people of the same gender in order to qualify for the competition, all 28 and under on 1st September 2023. Note only two team members may be aged 16 – 17 years. No one 15 or under may take part.

SAFEGUARDING:

All those aged 16 – 17 years MUST submit a JotForm Parental Permission Form no later than Wednesday 19th July at midnight. NO PAPER VERSIONS OF THE FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY. No members aged 15 or under may take part. Click here <u>https://form.jotform.com/231624217380349</u>

LIFE JACKETS: All Clubs must supply a minimum of 4 life jackets. Additional life jackets needed will be supplied by Staffordshire YFC (subject to availability). Anyone not wearing a life jacket will not be able to take part.

Rules and Health & Safety – applies to all Members and Rafts!

- Health and Safety must be a consideration at all times by the competitors and the stewards.
- All rafts will be subject to safety checks before entering the water. The Chief Stewards on the day have the right to disqualify any raft if it does not comply with safety standards and the ride rules.
- When booking in, all Competitors will have the full rules of the Raft Ride explained to them. Their Raft will also be checked at the same time.
- All competitors must sign to confirm that they are a competent swimmer. For those aged 16 17 years, parents will be asked to verify this on their permission slip.
- All Rafts will be subject to safety checks before entering the water and the stewards on the day have the right to not allow any unsafe rafts on the water.
- ALL team members must be competent swimmers.
- ALL team members must wear life jackets. Teams are asked to provide their own.
- All rafts must be man-powered only and have no sharp edges.
- <u>No alcohol is to be taken onto rafts or consumed before/during the ride.</u>
- No sports equipment such as surf boards etc. to be used.
- Competitors must remain on their raft, unless an emergency situation arises.
- Chemical drums <u>must</u> be thoroughly cleaned before use.
- All competitors on the raft must be able to carry the raft on their own (bearing in mind the various depths of the river).
- Competitors are responsible for their own rafts and any Clubs leaving items in the river at the start or finish of the race may be charged for the removal.
- Digital Membership cards will be requested. No card = no ride
- Any unacceptable behaviour by any individual or team, on the day, on or off the Raft, may result in disqualification of the team or Club. This is left to the discretion of the Stewards and Competitions Chairman on the day.


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
ROUTE:
