- Your team must ensure that they are ready to weigh in during this time.
- The competition will commence at 6pm prompt.
- We have affiliated Tug of War judges arranged for both competitions, in accordance with the NFU Insurance. Please would you ensure that your teams are aware of this, and fully read the enclosed NFYFC Rules which will be followed for this competition?
- Members, if eligible, may also take part in Class 36, the Mixed Rally Competition which will follow on from this competition.
- The county round of the NFYFC Male and Female Tug of War Competitions will take place at the County Show on Wednesday 31st May in the evening. Please would teams note that there are limitations to the competitors who take part in the NFYFC Competitions going forward from this round to WMA ie a team member cannot pull for their Junior Team and a Male/Female Team if they go forward from the County competition to the WMA round – they would need to chose which team to pull for.
