

White coats and clean Wellingtons must be worn. Prize Money kindly donated by the Staffordshire & Birmingham Agricultural Society will be presented along with certificates on the day to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed Overall. Up to 16 competitors in this competition will go forward to the WMA round – Sunday 21st July 2024, HVR Smith & Co, Park Farm, Eye, Leominster, HR6 0DL.
